We are delighted to be able to inform you that after three years our

has been successfully brought to a conclusion.

The final conference was held on 19 November 2016 in Ludwigsburg, where we gathered together with our partners from Germany, Island, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Spain and Sweden for a last time during the project which ran from Dec. 2013 – Nov. 2016. In addition, we were able to invite to the Pädagogische Hochschule (University of Education) in Ludwigsburg teachers, school principals, stakeholders and other interested parties from all over Europe as well as from North America and Japan who supported us in the three years of work on the ground.

After we had exchanged views on the “lessons learned” (plenary discussion on the Friday), the programme for the public conference on the Saturday was as follows:

1. Insights into the progress, project partners, methods and objectives of our project (for presentations see www.tdivers.eu);
2. Introductory talk by Tanja Sturm on the subject of “(Re)Producing and handling differences in subject teaching” (handout on the homepage);
3. Presentation of the USB stick with more than 20 hours of video materials (teaching sequences, school development, interviews with teachers, parents, school principals, students, etc.), texts, literature references to the Didactics of Diversity and Inclusive Education from the six partner countries. (The USB stick can be requested via the homepage);
4. In the afternoon 24 workshops took place providing insights into the inspiring practice of inclusive education (video recordings from six countries). The participating teachers, school principals, and researchers from the six countries were involved as workshop leaders.

The resulting material on the USB was developed and authorized for the purpose of teacher training. **Your own personal copy is enclosed with this letter.**

We would be very glad if you could use these materials in classes, courses, seminars and advanced training sessions for teachers or educators. And we would be delighted if you could give us feedback on your experience of working with the material compiled by us (see form at www.tdiver.eu). We will contact you about this again shortly.
